



Homeless Veteran Programs

Compensated Work Therapy (CWT) is comprised of three unique programs which assist homeless Veterans in returning to competitive employment:

1. Sheltered Workshop
2. Transitional Work
3. Supported Employment

Note: Veterans are paid at least the federal or state minimum wage.

Homeless Veteran Supported Employment Program (HVSEP) provides vocational assistance, job development and placement, and ongoing supports to improve employment outcomes among homeless Veterans and Veterans at-risk of homelessness. Formerly homeless Veterans who have been trained as Vocational Rehabilitation Specialists (VRSs) provide these services.

HUD-VA Supportive Housing (VASH) Program is a joint effort between the Department of Housing and Urban Development and VA. HUD allocated nearly 38,000 "Housing Choice" Section 8 vouchers across the country. These vouchers allow Veterans and their families to live in market rate rental units while VA provides case management services.

The Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) Program provides grants and technical assistance to community-based, nonprofit organizations to help Veterans and their families stay in their homes. Grantees provide eligible Veteran families with outreach, case management, and assistance in obtaining VA and other benefits, which may include: Health care services, Daily living services, Personal financial planning services, Transportation services, Fiduciary and payee services, Legal services, Child care services, and Housing counseling services.
